ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

**WHITE AVENUE DRAINAGE PROJECT
FOR TOWN OF PINE MOUNTAIN**

Sealed bids will be received by the Town of Pine Mountain for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment, and any other miscellaneous items necessary for construction of the White Avenue Drainage Project in the Town of Pine Mountain, Georgia.

Bids will be received to the attention of Mayor Keith Pendergrass at Town of Pine Mountain, 250 North McDougald Avenue, Pine Mountain, GA 31822 until **10:30 AM on Tuesday, October 24, 2023**. Any bid received after said time and date of bid opening will not be considered by OWNER. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at this time and location. All bids will be evaluated by OWNER and the project will be awarded, if it is awarded, within 45 days of the bid opening.

All questions shall be submitted in writing only to Natalie Pifer at 861np@ppi.us, and to be given consideration, must be received by no later than **10:00 AM on Wednesday, October 18, 2023**.

The Project consists of, but is not limited to the following major elements:

- Removal of 205 LF of 12” and 15” CMP and HDPE storm sewer pipes and structures
- Installation of 60 LF of 18” HDPE and 132 LF of 30” HDPE storm sewer pipes and structures
- Grading needed for ditches, swales and tie in slope
- Install a 2’ riser to an existing sanitary sewer pump station wet well

Project will also include traffic control and erosion sedimentation and pollution control installation and maintenance through the duration of the project.

A non-mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on **October 17, 2023 at 10:00am** at the Pine Mountain Town Hall

Time of completion for all work associated with the White Avenue Drainage Project shall be ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY (120) consecutive calendar days from the date of a written “Notice to Proceed” from OWNER.

Electronic access to the Contract Documents, Specifications, and Construction Drawings must be obtained from Precision Planning, Inc. emailing request to Natalie Pifer at 861np@ppi.us.

OWNER requires a bid bond* or a certified cashier's check in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid to be enclosed with the bid at the time of bid opening. Cashier's check will be made payable to Town of Pine Mountain.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish OWNER with Insurance, Workman's Compensation Insurance, and Performance and Payment Bonds* in the amount of one-hundred percent (100%) of the total bid.

Each bid must be submitted in a SEALED ENVELOPE, addressed to the OWNER. Each sealed envelope containing a Bid must be plainly marked on the outside as, **“White Avenue Drainage Project for the Town of Pine Mountain”**. If bid is forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the Bid must be enclosed in a separate mailing envelope to the attention of the OWNER at the address previously given.

All Bids must be made out on the bid form of the type bound in the Contract Documents, in accordance with the instructions in the Information for Bidders. No interlineation, additions, or deletions shall be made in the proposal form by the BIDDER.

Any and all Bids received without the aforementioned qualification criteria enclosed, will be returned to the BIDDER.

CONTRACTORS and SUBCONTRACTORS bidding on this Project will be required to comply with all Federal, State, and local laws.

OWNER reserves the rights to waive any informalities or to reject any or all Bids, to evaluate Bids, and to accept any Bid which in its opinion may be in the best interest of the OWNER. No Bid will be rejected without just cause.

Successful Bidder will be required to perform WORK as the Prime Contractor. WORK performed by Prime Contractor shall be at a minimum 30% of the contract value.

No BIDDER may withdraw his bid within the time limit specified in the Instruction to Bidders (Section 00100).

*** Surety companies executing Bonds must appear on the Treasury Department's most current list (Circular 570 as amended) and be authorized to transact business in the State of Georgia.**
