RESOLUTION FOR LHOST (LOCAL HOMESTEAD OPTION SALES TAX)

A resolution of the Mayor and council of the Town of Pine Mountain, Georgia, declaring the Town's intent to participate in and pursue implementation of the Local Homestead Option Sales Tax authorized by Georgia Law; authorizing further study, intergovernmental coordination, and preparation of necessary documents; and for other purposes.

LHOST reduces homestead property taxes, first. Requires a local Act of the General Assembly. Distributed proportionately among the county and participating cities based on their actual homestead digests. Excess proceeds are used to reduce millage rates across the board for all other property owners.

Mr. Trott made a motion to approve the Resolution for Harris County LHOST.

Ms. Mabry seconded the motion.

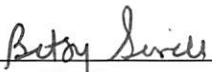
Mr. Bray and Mr. Pound voted in favor of the motion.

Mr. Bray seconded the motion.

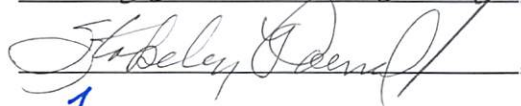
Mr. Trott and Ms. Mabry voted in favor of the motion.

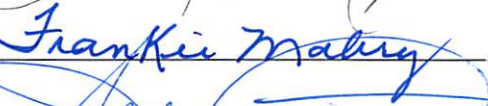
Thereafter, the meeting was adjourned.



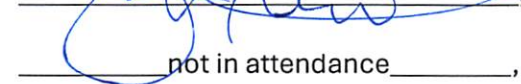
