JOHN DEERE BACKHOE MAINTENANCE

Per request from Mr. Scott on the October 14, 2024, work session Mr. Oliver received an estimate from John Deere for maintenance on the backhoe in the amount of \$2,997.00.

Our warranty expires in December 2025. John Deere suggested that we not enter into a maintenance contract at this time. Basically, we would be spending \$2,997.00 for nothing. We just need make a chart and keep up the hours and have the work done accordingly. If we used a 3rd party for maintenance, it would not void the warranty if John Deere supplies were used.

YARD SALE ORDINANCE
